The Energy Conservation Audit and Disclosure (ECAD) Ordinance, as described in Chapter 6-7: Energy Conservation of the Austin City Code, requires energy audits and disclosures for all residential facilities which are located within City of Austin and served by Austin Energy.

Conversely, residential facilities not located within the City of Austin or not served by Austin Energy are not subject to this Ordinance.

Records indicate that the residence at **416 BRANDON WAY** is either not served by Austin Energy or is not located within the City of Austin. Therefore, the ECAD ordinance does not apply. This determination expires twelve months after the date of this letter or when another ordinance is passed that supersedes this determination.

The following resources may be useful in determining if a property meets these two requirements:

- [Travis County Appraisal District \(TCAD\)](#) and [Williamson County Appraisal District \(WCAD\)](#)  
If the City of Austin is listed as a 'Taxing Jurisdiction' or 'Taxing Entity', then the residential facility is within Austin city limits.
- Refer to the residential facility's electric bill to verify the associated electric provider.
- [ECAD Map](#)  
This map displays the overlap in City of Austin and Austin Energy service territory. Properties that fall within the orange area are both within the City of Austin and receive Austin Energy service.\*
